

Nantwich Museum Shop – How to Order

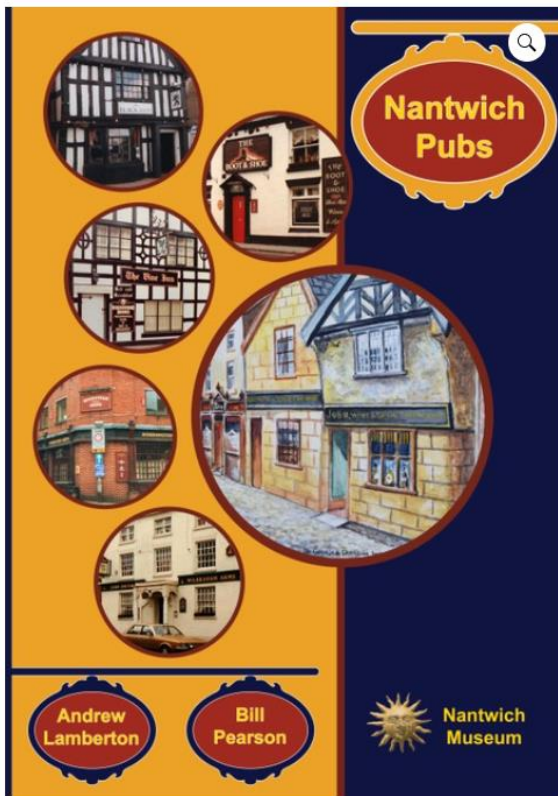

Nantwich Pubs provides a detailed look at the public houses in the town of Nantwich and give a street by street description, and history, of each licensed premises. The book is well illustrated, with pictures of the buildings themselves, and also the signs associated with many of them. Many pubs are now no longer in existence. Some have been demolished, or turned into private houses, or converted into restaurants and shops. Many have a unique story to tell, like selling beer containing arsenic to a child, and several are associated with ghosts!

If you were expecting an email, but did not receive it, please check your Spam folder before contacting the museum.

To complete the order, please then click on **Proceed to Paypal**.

You do not need a PayPal account to complete your order, we use PayPal to securely collect your money, and you can pay by your usual Credit or Debit Card.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What are the Printed Booklets?

A. Printed booklets are usually written by members of our Research Group, on specific subjects relating to the history of Nantwich and the surrounding area.

Q. What is the difference between a Digital Download and a Printed Booklet?

A. A Digital Download is a PDF file that has been copy protected. You will be sent an email straightaway, with a link to download this file. This has the advantage for you that you get the content instantly and save postage costs. It also saves the Museum the cost of paper and printing. If you prefer a printed booklet, we are trying to get as many as possible online. The content is usually the same for either item.

Q. What is a Webinar?

A. We currently offer webinars using Zoom, on a variety of different subjects. These are usually illustrated talks by members of our research group, on a wide range of aspects of the history of Nantwich, and the surrounding area. There is usually an opportunity to ask questions. The webinars keep changing, so please keep visiting to see what we have on offer.

Q. I live overseas. Can I still buy items?

A. We are actively looking to make available as much as possible to visitors outside the UK. If you need an item urgently, please contact the museum, and we will see what we can do.

Q. Why do you use PayPal?

A. We use PayPal as a secure way to collect your money. You do not need a PayPal account to make purchases from our shop.

Q. Where does my money go?

A. The vast proportion of funds go directly to Nantwich Museum, which is a registered charity, to support the work that it does in our community. A very small amount goes to PayPal (we get charity rates) as a handling fee, and we also have to meet printing costs on our books and booklets (which we endeavour to keep as low as possible).
